This memorable tour unites Christians on a journey to the Land of Israel. Walk in the places He walked, pray in the places He preached and experience the feeling of inner peace and tranquility. There is no better place on earth than the Holyland for Christians to feel the events of Jesus' life. Join us on this life altering experience.

ITINERARY

Saturday: En Route

Depart the USA on your transatlantic flights to Israel.

Sunday: Tel Aviv

Arrival to Ben Gurion Airport where you will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel. Overnight Tel-Aviv and Dinner at your hotel. (D)

Monday: Galilee

Depart Tel Aviv and drive along the coastal plain to **Caesarea**, once the Roman capital of the region; visit the excavations of the ancient city, the Roman theatre and aqueduct. Proceed to **Muhraka**, the site of confrontation between Elijah and the prophets of Baal; enjoy the spectacular view of the Jezreel valley and the lower Galilee. Continue to **Megiddo**, identified as the site of Armageddon; learn the impressive history of this battle field as you visit the archaeological excavations including the well-preserved water supply system. On to **Acre** to visit the remarkable underground Crusader City and crypt; walk through the Old City recognized by UNESCO as world heritage site, the local market and harbor. Continue to Kibbutz Lavi for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

Tuesday: Galilee

After a short tour of Tiberias to visit the birthplace of Mary Magdalene, enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee; visit the Yigal Alon center where the "Jesus Boat", an ancient fishing boat from the 1st century, is

displayed. Continue to Capernaum to visit the remains of the 2nd century synagogue. Stop at **Tabgha**, the site of the miracle of fish and loaves, and visit the **Church of Multiplication** with its 4th century mosaic floor. Proceed to **Mount of Beatitudes**, the place where Jesus delivered the sermon on the mount. Drive to **Yardenit**, the baptismal site on the Jordan River. Dinner and overnight at Kibbutz Lavi. (B,D)

Wednesday: Jerusalem

Drive to **Cana** to visit the **Wedding Church**, where Jesus performed his first miracle turning water into wine. Continue to **Nazareth** to visit the Church of Annunciation, Joseph's workshop and Mary's well. Proceed to **Beit Shean** to visit the newly excavated Roman city and amphitheatre. Drive along the Jordan valley to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

Thursday: Jerusalem

Drive to **Mount of Olives** for a panoramic view of the city; visit the **Church of All Nations**, **King David's Tomb** and **Room of Last Supper** on Mt. Zion. Enter the Old City; walk through the **Cardo**, the ancient roman road; visit the Jewish and Christian quarters; view the **Temple Mount**; visit the **Western Wall** and walk along the **Via Dolorosa** and the **oriental Bazaar** to visit the **Church of Holy Sepulchre**. Next, drive to the **Garden Tomb** and enjoy the beautiful gardens and peaceful ambiance. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Friday: Jerusalem

Drive to Ein Karem, birthplace of John the Baptist; visit the Church of Visitation and the Church of Saint John the Baptist. Visit the Israel Museum, the Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed and the Scale Model of the ancient city of Jerusalem as it was during the Second Temple period. Proceed to Bethlehem (subject to security conditions) birthplace of Jesus; visit Shepherds' field; walk through Manger Square to visit the Church of Nativity. Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B.D)

Saturday: Jerusalem

Drive through the Judean hills to Qumran caves, where the Dead Sea scrolls were found; Continue along the shores of the Dead Sea to Massada, the last stronghold of the Jews after the destruction of the Second Temple in 70 A.D.; ascend Massada by cable car and tour the mountain fortress built by King Herod; visit the remains of the walls, water cistern and Herod's Palace; descend by cable car. Continue to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth; enjoy the opportunity to float in the unsinkable water and cover yourself with the mineral rich mud, believed to have therapeutic effects. Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B.D)

Sunday: En Route

End of 7 Night Program

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight to the USA arriving the same day.

EILAT EXTENSION:

Sunday: Jerusalem/Eilat

Travel south through the Negev desert; stop at Timna, a large geological and archaeological park; marvel at the multi-colored rock formations and copper mines; view the outstanding King Solomon's pillars. See the Methuselah Tree in Ktura, a date palm grown from a 2000-year-old seed found at Masada. Continue to Eilat, the southernmost resort city on the shores of the Red Sea; visit the Underwater Observatory marine park, built into a coral reef and enjoy the opportunity for a close up look at the rich life of the Gulf of Eilat. Dinner and Overnight Eilat. (B.D)

Monday: Eilat

Day at leisure OR join the optional day tour to Petra (Jordan) including lunch, returning to Eilat. See details on page 49. (B.D or B.L.D).

Tuesday: Eilat – Tel Aviv

Depart Eilat via Mitzpe Ramon; stop to gaze into the Ramon crater, a geological wonder. Proceed to Kibbutz Sde Boker and see Ben Gurion's hut and grave overlooking the magnificent Zin valley. Continue for a visit to an authentic Bedouin tent. Learn about the Bedouin hospitality and enjoy a light lunch. Arrive in Tel Aviv for dinner and Overnight. (B.L.L.D)

Wednesday: En Route

Transfer to the Airport for your departure flight; special assistance is provided for check-in service.
