# **ITINERARY**

### Day 1: Arrive Cairo

Arrival Cairo; meeting, assistance and transfer to your hotel. Evening: Panoramic "Cairo by Night" tour and Dinner on the Nile. (D)

#### Day 2: Cairo

Begin the day with a visit to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. The Museum presents a rich, deep insight into Egyptian culture through the ages; enter the fascinating Mummy Room housing all 22 Mummies. Then continue to Giza to see the Three Great Pyramids, the oldest surviving structures built by man; enter one of the Pyramids. Stand in awe at the magnificent Sphinx carved out of a single piece of stone, guarding the Giza plateau. Try a camel ride before continuing for lunch at a local restaurant. On to the new, spectacular, must-see Grand Egyptian

Museum (GEM), (subject to museum opening), the largest archaeological museum in the world with objects covering 5000 years of ancient Egyptian civilization. GEM is host to over 100,000 artifacts, including King Tut's entire treasure collection. Return to Cairo for overnight. (B.L)

### Day 3: Cairo / Luxor

Morning flight to Luxor. First tour the vast Karnak Temple-Complex, built by generations of Pharaohs over a 2000-year period. After lunch, continue to the Avenue of the Sphinxes and the imposing Temple of Luxor with its grand colonnades. Evening: Optional Sound & Light Show at the Temple of Karnak (please reserve at time of booking). Overnight in Luxor. (B.L)

# Day 4: Luxor / Cairo

Morning tour the Valley of the Kings containing the secretive tombs of New Kingdom Pharaohs; enter the Tomb of Tutankhamen. Continue to the famed Colossi of Memnon, and the beautifully terraced Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir el Bahari. Return flight to Cairo; transfer to hotel and overnight in Cairo. (B)

Please Note: If there is a change in flight schedule between Cairo and Luxor, it may be necessary to conduct the Luxor sightseeing in one full day, rather than two half days.

#### Day 5: En Route

Transfer to Cairo Airport for your departure flight. (B)
